**WALK-IN INTERVIEW**

A Walk-In-Interview is scheduled to be held on **05.09.2023 at 10:30 AM** at ICAR-NRC on Mithun, Medziphema, Nagaland for engaging Three (03) position of Young Professional-II (YP-II) purely on contractual basis for one year and further extendable for two more years. The details of the post and Terms and Conditions are given below:-

**Scope/nature of job:-****I. YP-II (CIF Lab/Animal Health)**

1. Routine sample collection, disease diagnosis, bacterial culture and isolation, molecular characterization of pathogens etc.

**II. YP-II (Animal Nutrition section)**

1. Recording daily, the measured quantity of feed offered and residue of feed left by the experimental animals and determination of moisture content of those feeds is a regular feature in the Animal Nutrition Section
2. Recording body weights of the experimental animals at fortnightly interval is mandatory.
3. Recording length and girth of animals at fortnightly interval is also essential
4. Conducting metabolism trial on a regular interval is a feature for the experiments for determination of energy and protein requirements of animals which needs 24 hours supervision of animals for sample collection
5. Analysis of samples obtained from the experimental animals for determination of moisture, protein, fat and fiber contents is a tedious and time consuming job.
6. Further, the analysis of feed ingredients received from the feed suppliers is also a regular

feature of this Section. Therefore, it is essential to have a supportive hand in the form of Young Professional — II (YP - II) for this Section to perform the above mentioned activities.

**III. YP-II (TSP & Extension section)**

1. Data collection for the ongoing research project and its related works.
2. To assist in all preparation for Krishi Fair, mithun Mela, exhibition, health camp, etc.
3. To assist for maintenance of record keeping under TSP
4. To assist the section for timely report submission.
5. To assist the incharge for any miscellaneous work whenever arises.

**Terms & Conditions:**

1. Application addressed to the Director, ICAR-NRC on Mithun, Medziphema, Nagaland alongwith duly filled application form as per prescribed format must be produced at the time of interview.
2. The applicant must submit self-attested scanned copies of relevant documents/certificates along with prescribed application form with passport size photograph affixed. Applicants must bring with them all the original documents at the time of interview for verification.
3. Only the eligible candidates should come for the interview and must be present 45 minutes before the interview scheduled date/time for necessary formalities.
4. Age limit: The age limit is 21-45 years; relaxation to SC/ST/OBC/PH/ Ex-Serviceman/Women as per the Govt. of India instructions
5. The YPs in ICAR are eligible for 08 days leave in a calendar year on pro-rata basis and 02 restricted holidays as per the rules of Govt. of India/ICAR. They are full time workers and required to adhere to the administrative, financial and disciplinary regulations of ICAR-NRCM. Regular attendance will be maintained.
6. In case of serving candidate, NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from his/her employer and experience certificate in original must be produced.
7. Initially the period of engagement will be one year, and further extendable for two more years (01 year at a time) subject to requirement of the services of the YP in the organization and satisfactory performance of the candidate after evaluation by the Competent.
8. Positions are purely temporary, time bound, non-regular and on co-terminus basis with the project. Appointment can be terminated on one month's notice.
9. Service of the YPs shall be governed by ICAR revised Guidelines for hiring of technical manpower on short term basis issued vide OM No.Agril.Edn.1-06/2020-A&P dated 4.12.2020 and further clarification issued time to time.
10. The selected candidate shall have no legal right to claim regularization by absorption or otherwise against any regular posts or any further contractual engagement on termination of the project.
11. Canvassing in any form will disqualify the candidature.
12. Candidates reaching after the specified timing will not be entertained.
13. No TA/DA will be paid for attending the interview.
14. Decision of the Director, ICAR-NRC on Mithun, Nagaland shall be final and binding in all respects.
